All our coffees are made lovingly with double shots. Please check the blackboard for our current seasonal offerings. All coffees are also available as decaf and with soya or oat milk.

Skye Red 4.2% ABV / Skye Black 4.5% / Skye Gold 4.3%

500ml - £4.95 (Isle of Skye)

Three beauties from Isle of Skye! **The Red**, like the hills it's named after, is rounded and pleasing, smooth, malty and slightly nutty, a premium ale.

The Black is a stout-like beer, brewed with rolled oats and Scottish honey for plenty of bitter, dark, roasted oat and chocolaty depth. **The Gold** is a lighter, distinctively different ale, brewed with porridge oats for smoothness and a deep and creamy head.

Old Bridge Ale 4.1% ABV

500ml - £4.95 (Isle of Skye)

Also from Skye! Crafted from the crystal clear water from the Cuillin Hills that flows under the old Sligachan Bridge, this chestnut coloured ale has a hint of nuttiness and a well rounded taste.

Arran Blonde 5.0% ABV

500ml - £4.95 (Arran)

From an island off the Scottish West Coast comes a light golden-coloured beer with a white, quite persistent head. Fine citrus flavours with a real creaminess.

BrewDog Vagabond Pale Ale 4.5% ABV

330ml - £4.50 (Aberdeenshire)

Citrus and tropical fruit flavours meld with a light caramel malt base, giving way to a riot of resinous bitterness. This pale ale is brewed with 100% malted barley and American hops and is missing only one thing - gluten.

Skull Splitter Ale 8.5% ABV

330ml - £4.75 (Orkney)

A strong beer named after Thorfinn Einarsson the 7th Viking Earl of Orkney. A rich fruity wine-like complexity on the palate includes fresh and dried fruits, warm exotic spice and light summer citrus fruits. Sophisticated, satin smooth with a deceptively light character.

Innis & Gunn Oak Aged 6.6% ABV

330ml - £4.50 (Edinburgh)

An innovative product, this Edinburgh ale is aged in brand-new malt whisky barrels, made from American oak. The oak influence is more noticeable on the palate, where a luscious vanilla and caramel note permeates the beer. The freshness of the hops cuts through and the acidity is clean in the finish.

Connosseurs Choice Rare and Interesting 3rd Party Bottlings (35ml)

Caol Ila 2002, 46% Classic Islay malt distilled in 2002 and matured for 16 years in bourbon barrels with a limited release of 1,100 bottles. Salted butter, seaweed, sugared almond and lemon peel on the palate, richly coastal all the way through the finish.	£8.95	Glen Keith 1993, 49.3% One of the younger distilleries in Scotland, having only been founded in 1957 by the Chivas Brothers. This is only one of 205 bottles produced! Slightly herbaceous at first with pineapple and white grape notes followed by oily walnut and a lingering touch of golden syrup.	£10.95
Alit-A-Bhalne 1996, 50.8% A Speyside distillery in the town of Keith and one of the first designed to be operated by one person! This cask strength bottling was matured in a refill American hogshead for 22 years. Shortbread & sponge on the nose, citrus sweet takes centre stage on the palate.	£9.95	Glenatauchers 1991, 56.8% Glenatauchers' has always gone into blends on the lighter side. Accordingly, the set up - long ferments, slow distillation - lends itself to this style. This is cask strength though and bucks the trend with a palate of barley sugar, tobacco, chocolate brownies, cinnamon and quince!	£13.95
Glenburgie 2004, 46% Founded in 1810, this Speyside single malt is used in Ballantine's whose status as the second largest blend in the world accounts for the fact that Glenburgie sightings are as frequent as the Loch Ness monster! Fruitcake, pecans, guava and some spicy nutmeg will tease your palate!	£7.95	Tomatin 1989, 53.2% A highland malt from the village of Tomatin, it is thought that whisky has been distilled on the site since the 16th century, when cattle drovers would buy from a local still! Chocolatey notes arrive on the palate, followed by sharp green apple, buttery pastry and white pepper.	£16.95

OR freshen up with our **Brunch Martini** using Pear, Caorunn Gin, Cointreau, Apple juice and fresh lime for a massive wake-up call!

Sia Skyline - £8.95

Sia Royale **or** Negroni - £8.95 **or** Bellini - £5.95

Talk about lipsmacking refreshment with our **Sia Royale**! Organic Prosecco is mixed with Blackwoods Vodka, fruit presse and Limoncello from Southern Italy!
